## OVERVIEW

How often do the pressing needs of our world seem too big for a single individual? Too overwhelming for a small group of people? ## APPLICATION

2. Genesis 1:26 says that we are created in the image of God. Explain why your view of yourself aligns with or is skewed from this statement. What holds you back from living in this identity?
3. As Christ followers who were made in the image of God, we are equipped to make an impact. Has God been laying something on your heart that He wants you to do about the pressing need you mentioned in response to the first question?
4. Looking at Scripture and throughout history, we see time and time again where one person’s actions began a movement. What is one action step you can take today to “do for one what you wish you could do for everyone?”

**HOMEWORK:** Like the famous Nike slogan says, “Just do it”! Go and do for one what you wish you could do for everyone.
