OVERVIEW

The old hymn says, “Turn your eyes upon Jesus, look full in His wonderful face.” God is delighted to meet us in our moment of physical need, but He is offering us so much more. His desire is to draw us closer to Him. However, we often allow the “bread” to meet our physical need, but don’t allow Him to meet the spiritual need that we have. God wants our eyes turned to Him. Are you settling for something less than what Jesus is offering?

Scriptures: John 6:25-70; Philippians 3:8

APPLICATION

- Look up the words to the old hymn, *Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus*. What is something about the words that stands out to you?
- Steve mentioned that the people were looking at Jesus, wondering what He was going to do for them. How do your thought patterns mimic this selfish mentality?
- Jesus wanted to give them the best gift...Himself, but the people settled for the bread. What are some things other than Jesus that you are seeking for fulfillment and satisfaction?
- John 6:66 says, “From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.” How are you turning your back on Jesus and settling for something less than He is offering?
- What is one next step you can take to allow God to fulfill you rather than the thing you mentioned above?

NEXT STEP: Each morning, start your day by listening to the hymn, *Turn Your Eyes on Jesus*. Allow Him to be the bread of life in your day and turn your eyes toward Him.
