

Disobedience – 7/4/2021

OVERVIEW

Despite Moses and Aaron's past leadership, we see that a single encounter kept them from entering the Promised Land. The thing that hijacks dreams and visions is disobedience. Where is God asking you to say "Yes"? How are you going to obediently move to those places God is calling you?

Scriptures: Numbers 20:1-13; Deuteronomy 8:14-16

APPLICATION

- Icebreaker: Dave talked about taking a trip to Israel in celebration of his 50th birthday. If money was no option, what is one thing you would want for a birthday present?
- When listening to the account of the waters of Meribah, do you relate most to the Israelites, to Aaron, or to Moses? Explain your choice.
- We see in Numbers 20:12 that Moses and Aaron were not allowed to enter the Promised Land because "they did not believe in me (God)." What is your reaction to this punishment? Why do you think it was so severe?
- When we say "Yes" to God, it helps *us* see God, but it also helps *others* see God. What is an area where is God asking you to say "Yes"? It could be forgiveness, a ministry opportunity, loving an unloving spouse, an action you need to take, etc.
- What is keeping you from saying "Yes" or taking action?
- NEXT STEP: Think about the area that God is stirring in your heart where you need to say "Yes." What is your next step?
