APPLICATION

- Woody shared a Dallas Willard quote that says, "Grace is not opposed to effort, but it is opposed to earning." What does Dallas Willard mean in that statement?
- According to the scriptures above, God gave each of us a special gift. How are you currently using your gift as a functioning member of the Body of Christ?
- Some characteristics of a person who is moving and maturing in Christ are:
 - a. Understanding what is true and what is false (knowing the Word of God)
 - b. Being in authentic community
 - c. Functioning as part of the Body of Christ

EVALUATE: Look at the above list and evaluate the effort and intentionality you are putting toward each section.

BE PRACTICAL: Woody asked a few questions that might help you in your evaluation: Am I regularly involved with the intake of and interaction with the Word of God? Am I regularly participating in authentic Christian community? Am I regularly involved in serving and giving in my Christian community?
